Areas of Practice

Before joining Lifang & Partners, Mr. Li served on the bench at Shenzhen Nanshan District People's Court for 16 years, during which time he was promoted from judge to Vice President of the Criminal Division. He has tried all kinds of criminal cases but specialized in cases involving embezzlement, bribery and other employee crimes, commercial crimes (such as credit card fraud, contract fraud, Ponzi schemes, etc.), and other property related offenses.

During his tenure in office, Mr. Li presided over 28 trials involving government officials and 60 corruption cases. Typical cases include:

- The prosecution of Chen, Zhuang and Huang, both of whom worked in the Shenzhen Shekou Entry-Exit Inspection and Quarantine Bureau and were found guilty of bribery and dereliction of duty;
- The prosecution of Ou who worked in a branch of the Shenzhen Social Insurance Fund Administration and acted corruptly;
- The prosecution of Li who worked in the Shenzhen government procurement center and was found guilty of taking bribes;
- The prosecution of Cui who was a former principal of the Shenzhen Police School and was found guilty of taking bribes; and
- The prosecution of Wu, a Shenzhen customs officer, who took bribes.
- The prosecution of the 2015 Guangming landslide incident, in which five people were convicted of dereliction of duty.

He was also the principal judge in a series of high-profile corporate bribery cases in which Liu, a former senior executive of the Alibaba Group, and Zheng, a former chairman of the Shenzhen Tianxia Group, and others were convicted.

Mr. Li dealt with more than 1,300 criminal cases. In 2009, he was given the Excellent Worker in Nanshan District, Shenzhen Award. That same year, he won another honor for his good service in advancing social stability in Nanshan District, Shenzhen. From 2009 to 2013, he was given the award of "Expert in Case Handling" by the Nanshan Court. He was also a winner of the title of "Trial Expert" by Shenzhen Intermediate People's Court in 2014.
